ON THE STATION'S MAIN CHANNEL

St. Louis Public Radio | 90.7 KWMU announces the addition of year-round classical music as part of the Saturday evening program schedule on the station's main channel, 90.7 KWMU. The schedule changes, listed below, will take effect July 31, 2010.

- ***From the Top***, a classical music variety show, will air on St. Louis Public Radio | 90.7 KWMU from 7:00 - 8:00 p.m. *From the Top*, hosted by acclaimed pianist Christopher O'Riley, features high-caliber performances along with interviews, sketches and games, revealing the heart and soul behind extraordinary young musicians. Over the years some of the most prominent figures in classical music have appeared alongside young talent on *From the Top*, including Yo-Yo Ma, Hilary Hahn, Bobby McFerrin, Midori, Béla Fleck and many more. *From the Top* is distributed by NPR.
